- Completed federal and state level registrations for client that started a hazardous waste transportation division which successfully expanded coverage throughout the midwest and south.
- Assisted in completion of air permitting for clients in the industrial coatings industry. Avoided client's exposure to notice of violations by the regulatory community.
- Compiled numerous Industrial Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans and effectively managed the coordination of storm water sampling in order to maintain compliance with discharge permits and to prevent significant impacts to waters of the U.S.
- Performed Phase 1 and 2 Environmental Site Assessments and brought environmental liabilities that were discovered to the client's attention.
- Assisted in USACE Jurisdictional Determination for a proposed fractionation sand mine and recommended that client avoid mining in the jurisdictional area, which reduced initial start up costs by approximately \$30,000, avoiding additional permitting.

- Awarded contract by major development company which saved client hundreds of dollars per residence over the previous contractor. Responsible for management of lead clearance sampling contract at the Naval Air Station-Joint Reserve Base in Ft. Worth, Texas to insure the health and safety of new homeowners.
- Conducted waste characterization and disposal of 200 waste drums at a paint manufacturing facility. The client had previously received RCRA notice of violations from the TCEQ and our involvement helped avoid costly citations from the state.
